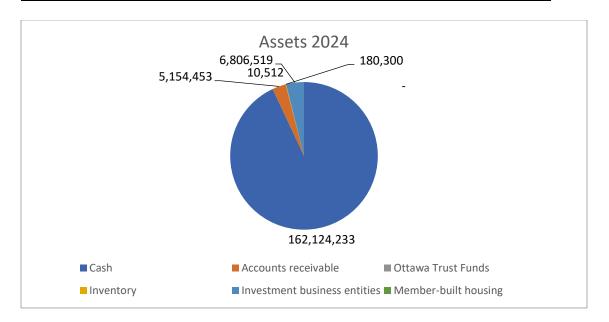
Williams Lake First Nation – 2023-2024 Financial Overview

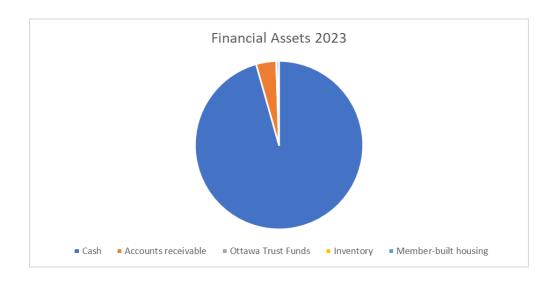

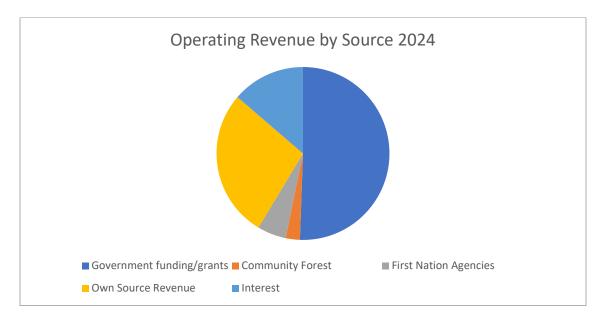

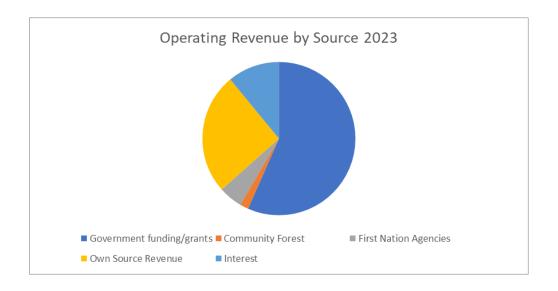
